



Notes for New St. Mark's Parents

School Uniforms

St. Mark's believes uniforms enhance the school environment by encouraging discipline and a positive academic attitude.

Students wear white or red collared shirts with navy slacks/shorts/skirts/jumpers. For girls, a large blue and red plaid is acceptable. For safety reasons, we ask all students to wear tennis shoes.

Solid navy blue, red or white jackets may be worn inside the building or classroom. Students may not wear jackets or sweatshirts with logos to class.

Parents have the opportunity to embroider the St. Mark's mascot lion on any or all uniform clothing. Embroidery services are available at Land's End and locally at Ink Spot. Pre-Kindergarten

The Pre-Kindergarten school day begins at 8:15. We ask Pre-K parents to park and walk their children directly to the classrooms, and pick them up at the classroom at 2:45. This policy is imperative for the safety of the children.

Carpool

We run two carpool lines at the end of the school day for grades Kinder - 8th. You will receive information before school starts.

Hot Lunch Program

The kitchen staff at St. Mark's prepares a hot lunch every day. You have the option of pre-ordering this lunch or students may bring a sack lunch. An August menu will be sent to you before school begins.

Supplies

Students need to provide their school supplies the first week of school. You will receive a list from your child's grade level before the beginning of classes.

Field Trip T-Shirts

You will be asked to provide us your child's t-shirt size so that we can purchase shirts that are worn on field trips and to other special events.
